Each day you will have 3 hours of instruction, drills and light scrimmages that will get focused on the upcoming fall season. The camp will stress the correct way to pass, set, hit and serve as well as basic team Offense and Defense. Bring a couple of friends and come have fun playing the great game of volleyball! If you plan to try out for club ball in the fall this camp will get you started in the right direction. (Only open to 6th graders with club experience)
